

## Windyridge Garden at Mount Wilson

**Date:** Thursday 9 May 2024.

Windyridge Garden is a privately owned 5 acre garden that has been featured on Better Homes and Gardens on Channel 7. The Garden is landscaped with different themes and has a large selection of Japanese maples throughout the garden, camellias, rhododendrons, peonies, azaleas and hydrangeas. The garden also has several different types of trees such as Cedrus deodara, copper beech, pin oaks, ginkos, dogwoods and nyssas.

- Waterfall and rainforest
- Parterre Garden (formal European style garden)
- Entertainment Lawn
- Various outdoor artworks such as bronze statues and ceramics
- The White and the Blue Gardens

**Windyridge Garden is located at 25 Queens Avenue, Mount Wilson.**
